To Participate (it's easy as one, two, three ...)

1. Use the above table to identify the camp you want to participate in.
2. **By the end of February**, contact the Pack 62 Camping Coordinator (contact information is below) and provide the following information to allow the pack to obtain an accurate count (the pack needs an accurate count to complete priority campership applications):
 - Name(s) of scout(s) attending
 - Which camp(s) they will be attending (i.e., 1, 2, and/or 3 above)
3. Provide the following to the Pack Camping coordinator on or before 28March2010 to take advantage of discounted cost (or 28May2010 for full cost).
 - Completed camp registration forms for those attending (will provided by the camping coordinator and Pack events).
 - Completed BSA Medical Record form Parts A and C for the cub and any adults attending. NOTE: Completing this form generally does NOT require a physician visit. The form can be accessed at http://scouting.org/filestore/pdf/34605_Letter.pdf.
 - A check payable to "Mount Horeb Cub Scout Pack 62" for the cost (less any camping credits the scout has accumulated).

Tips

1. All Pack 62 scouts receive \$25 of camping credit from the pack plus an additional \$25 of camping credit for every \$500 of popcorn sold during the Fall Pack popcorn sale for use during the 2009-2010 scouting year. Available credit will applied to these camping events, but it is "use or loose" proposition as credit does not carry over to the next scouting year!
2. Plan to take initiative for checking the Glacier's Edge web site (<http://www.glaciersedge.org/>) to understand what those attending need to bring to camp and when they need to arrive. The council has not historically sent additional communication or reminders about camps. You need to take responsibility for getting to camp with needed "provisions" at the requisite date and time.
